

40 Year Anniversary of the Camp David Peace Accords (2018)

This year (2018) is going to be the 70th anniversary of the establishment of the modern-day state of Israel (in May), and the 40th anniversary of the Camp David Peace Accords (in September).

May through September is the five month season of the locust army. For those who don't know what happens, Biblically speaking, during the five month period of the locust army, consider reading Revelation 9. It's basically a five month period of intense deception, leading up to the arrival of the antichrist at the sound of the sixth trumpet.

By the way, the number 40, in Biblical numerics, stands for *probation*. In other words, probation is over in September of this year. They've had 40 years to achieve peace, and have not even come close. And the time is just about up. This may be why you hear so much talk of president Trump frantically heading to Israel to meet with the Arabs over a proposed Middle East "peace" deal.

The number 70, in Biblical numerics, stands for Israel's restoration. But Israel will not be restored (in the Biblical sense) until Christ Jesus comes. All attempts at achieving "peace" without the Prince of Peace will ultimately be futile. As it's written:

Thessalonians 5:3 -- For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.

If this is the year, then sudden destruction will be the end result of Trump's Middle East peace plan. After all, there can be no peace in the Middle East without the Prince of Peace. And Israel as it exists today rejects the Prince of Peace, as do their neighbors the Muslims.

But as the Scripture states, the Judaics will not reject the false Christ, which is to say, the antichrist. As Jesus told them:

John 5:43 I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

We know from II Thessalonians 2:1-4 that the false Christ -- that "man of sin, the son of perdition" -- comes to this earth and seats himself in the temple of God, portraying himself as "God," just before Christ's Second Advent.

Could this be the year, during the course of a five month period of intense deception running from May through September? Well, we won't know until the time passes. But that's why the Lord calls His servants "watchmen." We're to watch as the prophesy unfolds...

The original Camp David peace accords were signed on September 17, 1978, essentially bringing a semblance of “peace” to the Middle East as long as American taxpayers keep paying both sides not to go to bomb the living daylights out of each other.

Since the time those peace accords were signed, we’ve paid out billions upon billions of dollars each and every year in taxpayer money to Egypt and Israel, which amount to little more than “peace bribes,” with the implication being that if Egypt and Israel don’t “keep the peace” in the Middle East, the ongoing flow of U.S. money will dry up.

And as I mentioned, this year (2018) is the 40th year since those original peace accords were signed. So, spiritually speaking, we have a 40 year generation coming up on this bought-and-paid-for “peace” in the Middle East.

Again, the number “40” is the Biblical number of probation, as in the Old Testament Israelites marching through the wilderness for 40 years before being able to enter the Promised Land. So stay on the watch, because in this sense, “probation” is just about up in the Middle East.

And always remember, it was little David who slew the Philistine (read: *Palestinian*) giant, Goliath, with a wound to the head. And it’s a wound to the head that constitutes the deadly wound of Revelation. As it’s written:

Rev 13:3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast.

Let’s be careful to watch to see if the current conflict over the Temple Mount gradually becomes a “giant” one. We know that the false Jews (Kenites) are the *sixth* head to rule over Jerusalem. All five previous heads that ruled over Jerusalem (Babylon, Medo-Persia, Grecia, Rome, Mohammadan Empire) have already fallen. As it’s written:

Rev 17:9 And here *is* the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth.

Rev 17:10 And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.

So there’s only one “head” (or kingdom) over Jerusalem still in existence today. That’s the Judaic head, which is largely composed of the Christ-hating false Jews of Revelation 2:9 and 3:9, with some of our brother Judah sprinkled in among them.

That “other” head, or king(dom), has not yet come. That’s Satan himself, with his “Mystery, Babylon the Great” kingdom, who arrives to heal the deadly wound to that one “head” (or kingdom) that’s still in existence and is currently in power over Jerusalem. He will then usher in his global version of Brother Love’s Travelling Salvation Show, ensnaring the world into believing he’s the promised Messiah.

Of course, please understand that I'm not predicting the "end." But *watch*. We live in critical times now, Biblically speaking. And this is no time to be asleep at the wheel. With a 70 year anniversary of Israel's establishment as a nation in these modern times coming up in May, and a 40 year generation of so-called Middle East "peace" coming to a close this September 2018, it *might* be time to start expecting the unexpected.
