

Oh, God: Hold Not Thy Peace: A Study for Our Times in Psalm 83



Let's collectively – as One Body – pray the following Psalm to the Good Lord, keeping in mind that Father's Word tells us, prophetically, that the *first* attempt at forcing one-worldism on the western Christian nations *fails*. As it's written:

“And in those times there shall many stand up against the king of the south: also the robbers of thy people shall exalt themselves to establish the vision; but they shall fall.” (Dan. 11:14)

As I stated in a previous Bible study, you can almost see the assaults on Trump in the first part of that verse, right?

“Many” indeed have stood up against the “king of the south” (if you agree with Pastor Arnold Murray's revised teaching from the late 90's that the “king of the south” is now the American leader, while the “king of the north” is now the Russian leader).

And of course, the “robbers of thy people” are clearly the Kenites. It's extremely clear the Kenites are the ones pushing this tyrannical global COVID ruse as a means of eliminating nationalism and instituting “we're-all-in-this-together” global communism, Bolshevik style.

So, if *now* is the time for Daniel 11:14 to come to pass, then the COVID ruse will ultimately fail...IF enough of God's servants have the intestinal fortitude (and the Biblical faith and understanding) to claim that verse, and boldly stand up in Christ's name against what's happening.

Then, the Kenites would have to come back later, from a completely different angle, to "establish the vision," which is to say, to usher in their daddy's New World Order.

With that in mind, here's the Psalm with which, if you want to, you can join in prayer with me to the heavenly Father:

Psa 83:1 A Song or Psalm of Asaph. Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God.

During a serious time of national trouble, Asaph is making a cry for help to the Most High God, our heavenly Father, YHVH, the Self-Existent One.

The name, or title "Asaph" means "gatherer of the people." When the enemy attacks, we're supposed to gather the people, and this is what we're to pray with them, in claim of His Word:

Psa 83:2 For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head.

The enemies of God are making their move against His People. As I stated, I honestly believe they're ultimately going to fail this time around, because of Daniel 11:14. But we've got to *claim* it, if we believe it.

Psa 83:3 They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones.

They sure have. The goal of the robbers of our people has always been to extinguish Christianity from the face of the earth. And as you can see from the events of this past year, the bulk of this COVID ruse has been directed against the western Christian nations. *It's all designed to make us subservient to the earthly forces of Satan himself.*

God's "hidden ones" mentioned in the verse above, are His elect. Yes, the enemy knows who we are. And they consult against us, because we're the Body of Christ – this earth's walking, talking body that brings forth His Word -- which they hate, loathe and despise, and wish to fully and finally destroy.

But what sayeth the Lord regarding this matter? "*Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm*" (1 Chronicles 16:22; Psalm 105:15). And "...*see thou hurt not the oil and the wine*" (Rev. 6:6).

So, if they touch you, they're poking their finger in the eye of God. And they might just end up drawing back a bloody stump in the process, for Father does not like His Elect Body – His very wife -- to be molested by anybody.

Psa 83:4 They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.

The presence of True Israel on this earth is the *only* thing physically ruining the enemy's ability to pull off the Kenite's con that they're "God's chosen people."

The entire world can see that True Israel (especially Israel's regathering in the west, and later migration to the Americas) is blessed, and that the parasitic middle east nation of Israel being run by the children of Cain can only survive through their incessant parasitism.

In other words, we Christians inherited the blessings of Abraham, for our faith (Galatians 3:7). And the enemy has to *rob* our people of those blessings in order to stay alive and prosper.

Psa 83:5 For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee:

Through their strategic positions over the four hidden dynasties of politics, economics, education and religion, they "consult together with one consent" against the Lord and His earthly Elect Body. Which means, of course, that *they're on Satan's side*.

Psa 83:6 The tabernacles of Edom, and the Ishmaelites; of Moab, and the Hagarenes;

Psa 83:7 Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre;

Psa 83:8 Assur also is joined with them: they have holpen the children of Lot.
Selah.

Most of these are representative of the nations and peoples who have long ago turned against the Lord and His Chosen, and have been robbing us ever since in order to sustain themselves.

As you can see, verse 8 ends with the word "Selah," which means to stop and think about it, before connecting the following verses with it.

So, let's pause for a moment to do just that:

Edom, of course, are the descendants of Esau, Jacob's twin who sold out his birthright from God for a single bowl of pottage. It's widely considered that the Edomites are the

Russian communists of today. Not the good Christians of Russia, of course, but the anti-God rulership operating *behind* the scenes.

The **Ishmaelites** and **Hagarenes** are largely the Muslim Arabs of today who descended from Ishmael, Abraham's son through his concubine, Hagar.

Moab constitutes the descendants of Lot (Abraham's brother) through his incestuous relationship with his eldest daughter who got him drunk and seduced him in order to become pregnant, because she (and her sister) thought they were the only people left alive on this earth after God destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah with fire and brimstone.

Gebal was a maritime nation near the Kenite stronghold of Tyre. Ezekiel 27:9 tells us they were caulkers of ships who apparently made oceanic merchant trade for the middle east nations possible. Little is known about them, but from their tie-in with Tyre and overseas merchant trade, by ship, you can see them, symbolically, in the description of the fall of Mystery, Babylon in Revelation 18.

Ammon constitutes the descendants of Lot through his incestuous relationship with his younger daughter, who participated in the seduction of her father with her older sister after Sodom and Gomorrah were destroyed.

Amalek was the grandson of Esau, Jacob's twin.

It's not clearly known for sure who the **Philistines** were descended from, but William Smith, of Smith's Bible Dictionary, seems to believe they were of the Caphtorim, descendants of Mizraim, which are the Egyptians of old, mentioned in Genesis 10 as a *child of Noah's son Ham*.

The Philistines eventually migrated into the land of Canaan (the land that had been settled by Ham's son, Canaan) in the great plain of Philistia, today known as Palestine – yes, the Palestinians.

Tyre, as I mentioned earlier, was a Kenite coastal stronghold of ship-building and sailing merchants. The name "Tyre" means "a rock," and, of course, Satan himself, the false rock, is symbolized as both the Prince of Tyre and the King of Tyre in Ezekiel 28.

For many years the people of Tyre were closely allied, through trade, with Israel, during David and Solomon's time. But after King Josiah instituted the reformation in Israel (after the split into two kingdoms) and heaped insults on the gods who, quite specifically, were the objects of Tyrian veneration and love, that close alliance was over.

According to Smith's Bible Dictionary, Josiah's act was "regarded by the Tyrians as a series of sacrilegious and abominable outrages." So the alliance between Israel and Tyre ended when Josiah rejected the Tyrian gods and re-established the worship of YHVH.

Josiah, of course, was a very wise and Godly man. He recognized that false religion can creep in, in many different ways, and one of the main ways is through merchant trade. It's called "the love of money," and it's described by Christ as "the root of all evil." Again, check out Revelation chapter 18 and "see" the world merchant trading system destroyed by our Lord and Savior at His second advent.

Assur is the same as Asshur, the grandson of Noah who would later be worshipped as the chief "god" of Assyria, the land of Asshur. They were largely peopled out of Babylon, which, of course, was originally founded at Babel by the descendants of Noah (Genesis chapter 10).

Why did we go through this list?

The bottom line is that those listed in this verse are largely *family* to True Israel. Unfortunately, for them, it's the side of the family that rebelled against God and that hates, loathes and despises the People of God because we have the blessings and they don't.

You can see this family division today, as our nation – and the rest of the western Christians nations – are split between those who love God and His Word, and those who utterly disdain and ridicule God and His Word and anyone who attempts to bring forth that Word to the rest of the world in this present state of darkness.

Now, with that in mind, think back to the first age, the world that was, when Satan's rebellion drew one-third of God's children to back Satan in his attempt to usurp the throne of God, which is what precipitated this flesh earth age in the first place. *That* was a *family* split, as well. It's *all* about the family split, from the beginning to the very end.

But what do you do, when various branches of the family turn against the branch that God has blessed...the branch that actually sustains them...and tries to destroy them from within and without? Let's see:

Psa 83:9 Do unto them as unto the Midianites; as to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook of Kison:

Father trounced the Midianites, Israel's oppressors, through Gideon and his troops (Judges 8:28). He destroyed them.

He also slaughtered Jabin and Sisera, Israel's oppressors, through Deborah, Barak, Jael, and even the angels above who joined in the fight (Judges chapter 4).

So, here, Asaph, the gatherer of the people, calls on our heavenly Father to act once again, swiftly and decisively, against the tyrannical oppressors of His People. He asks the Lord to take them out, as He did in the times of old when they overstepped their bounds.

Psa 83:10 Which perished at Endor: they became as dung for the earth.

Our heavenly Father killed them dead. Why? Because their oppression of Israel had gone too far.

In Gideon's day, they were, for example, starving Israel to death by robbing them of all food supplies (Judges 6:4).

If you've read about Agenda 21/30, and the other Rockefeller plans for the western Christian nations, you know this is *exactly* what the purveyors of "global population control" are up to now, preparing to implement the moment they feel they have us firmly enough in their vice-grip and under their collective thumbs.

But what does the Psalmist pray to the Lord?

Psa 83:11 Make their nobles like **Oreb**, and like **Zeeb**: yea, all their princes as **Zebah**, and as **Zalmunna**:

Oreb and Zeeb, and Zebah and Zalmunna, were the chief Midianites who were starving Israel to death.

They were the perpetrators of what today, we call the "food shortages." You got a taste of it this past year, when store shelves went bare because the enemy shut down food production. And if you don't think this "dark winter" that Biden has promised us is going to be even worse, you don't understand the enemy, in the least.

So, the Psalmist calls out to God, asking for the *deaths* of Israel's oppressors, just as God had destroyed the oppressive and tyrannical nobles of the Midianites back in Gideon's day.

I'll throw out a few names for you, of some of our most obvious oppressors and robbers, today:

Anthony Fauci. Bill Gates. Tedros Adhanom (head of WHO). Andrew Cuomo. Bill de Blasio. Gavin Newsom. Gretchen Whitmer. Kate Brown. Jay Inslee. Michael Bloomberg. Nancy Pelosi. Joe Biden. Kamala Harris.

Do with those names as you want. I'm sure you could add a few more to a list of your own. And keep in mind they're just the figures the public gets to see and here. The true power behind them, is always behind the scenes. It's the enemies of your Lord and Savior. You know who they are.

Most Christians today are too damned polite to ask God to take out an enemy. I'm not. Neither was the Psalmist.

If it's in His will to destroy our oppressors, or take out their power-structure, then He *will*. So, at the very least, let's ask for His will in the matter. We're not the judge. But we can ask the Judge to protect and save us, and give Him the specifics of what's happening, just as the Psalmist has done in these verses.

He's your heavenly Father, for goodness sakes. Who else do you have to turn to when the robbers of our people – the tyrannical oppressors who wish to make God a distant memory in our minds and reduce us to crushed and obedient servants of their father the devil – begin to act far outside of their bounds against us.

Psa 83:12 Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession.

Do you understand? That's *exactly* what they're attempting to do to us, today.

Shutting down churches.

Making directives against home Bible study groups.

Preventing singing praises to God in the choir, or even at home.

Arresting pastors for holding church services.

And turning other pastors, who once preached boldly, into spineless wimps, cowering before Big Brother and shuttering their churches in fear.

Psa 83:13 O my God, make them like a wheel; as the stubble before the wind.

The word "wheel" should be translated "whirlwind." The Psalmist – the gatherer of the people – is asking Father to utterly destroy the oppressor...to turn them into stubble with His great power and authority.

After all, they're nothing but parasitical weeds, euphemistically speaking. And what do you do with parasitical weeds in your garden? You yank them out by the roots and toss them into the 55 gallon burning barrel. Right?

Psa 83:14 As the fire burneth a wood, and as the flame setteth the mountains on fire;

Psa 83:15 So persecute them with thy tempest, and make them afraid with thy storm.

Look, even today, their sins against our Christian people are not only obvious, but egregious, and growing darker and more dangerous by the moment. Already, the supposedly "temporary" mask mandates, social distancing and lockdowns are back in force. So are the lies and deception. Soon, they'll be forcing the RNA genetic vaccines on us – over a virus with a demonstrated 99.86% survival rate.

What's more, the robbers of our people have been given space to repent, but instead of doing so, have blatantly doubled-down on their oppression and robbery.

How many more of our elderly, for example, must die alone and afraid with no family, ruthlessly tucked away like garbage in some dark and dank "care home" where they're not even allowed to receive family visitors?

No. The enemy doesn't learn. And doesn't care. They've been ruthless and relentless, from the start. They *continue* to be ruthless and relentless, to this day. They need to be taken out. The Lord can do it. Turn to Him in prayer.

What's more, the enemy has arrogantly shown us, quite clearly, through the words on the Georgia Guidestones, through the Rockefeller Foundation documents, through the Agenda 21/30 documents, and much more, that they plan to continue until they destroy the very foundation of the western Christian nations and ultimately subjugate us to the one they've chosen to follow, which is the devil himself.

The Psalmist continues...

Psa 83:16 Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O LORD.

Psa 83:17 Let them be confounded and troubled for_ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish:

Psa 83:18 **That men may know that thou, whose name alone is YHVH, art the most high over all the earth.**

Father *will* protect His People...IF they'll repent and call on Him for help. I remind you once again that Daniel 11:14 says:

"And in those times there shall many stand up against the king of the south: also the robbers of thy people shall exalt themselves to establish the vision; but they shall fall." (Dan. 11:14)

Let's *claim* that promise from God. Let's ask father, personally and collectively, to intervene. And when He does, let's not rest on our laurels afterwards. Let's clean house in this country. And in our own personal lives.

We need to get rid of the porn...the transgender nonsense...the "gay marriage" filth...the communism disguised as "progressive policy"...the filthy TV shows that have become nothing but propaganda outlets for Satanic actions...and much more.

So cast all of the "leaven" out of your house, and turn to your heavenly Father, in sincere prayer. Pray this very Psalm to Him.

Surely you believe in the power of prayer. Surely you understand that Father *hears* those who love His Word, and *answers* their prayers.

Put some starch in your backbone. Put on the Gospel Armor, and wage some serious spiritual warfare, for a change. It's what you're *here* for, after all.

Our God is a God of love. But He's also a God of great wrath. And His wrath is triggered when His servant People are being beaten down. What's more, it's *always* designed to glorify His name by the defeat of the enemy. It let's us know He loves us. And it let's them know, in no uncertain terms, they've gone one step too far, in His eyes.

Let's never forget that. As the martyrs of God under the altar in heaven have prayed:

How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? (Revelation :10)

Our heavenly Father tells us to pray, and to set before Him our petitions for help. So, let's get busy and do so! As it's written:

Psa 34:17 *The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.*

Psa 145:18 *The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.*

Psa 145:19 *He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.*

Psa 145:20 *The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.*

Psa 145:21 *My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.*

1Pe 3:12 *For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.*

1Jn 5:14 *And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:*

1Jn 5:15 *And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.*

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, **ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.**

Joh 15:8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

Joh 15:15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.

Joh 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: **that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.**

Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, **That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.**

Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, **What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

Mar 11:25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Mar 11:26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Mic 7:7 Therefore I will look unto the LORD; I will wait for the God of my salvation: **my God will hear me.**

Mic 7:8 Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD shall be a light unto me.

Mic 7:9 I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, and I shall behold his righteousness.

Mic 7:10 Then she that is mine enemy shall see it, and shame shall cover her which said unto me, **Where is the LORD thy God? mine eyes shall behold her: now shall she be trodden down as the mire of the streets.**

Psa 50:14 Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High:

Psa 50:15 And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me.


Heb 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession.
